

3 Day Company Security Officer Training Course

ISPS Code & Australian MTOFS Act & Regulations 2003. To the requirements of IMO Model Course 3.20 (2012).

This interactive classroom course is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, a former shipping industry executive with 50 years' of maritime industry involvement. His specialising in implementation of the ISPS Code and its associated codes, legislation and regulations commenced late in 2003, when the Code was conceived.

Aims

To provide essential knowledge to those who may be designated by the operator of a ship, MODU or self-propelled FPSO, to perform the duties of a Company Security Officer with responsibility for preparing ship security assessments, development and implementation of the company's security policy and assisting the company's Ship Security Officers to properly implement and maintain their security plan.

Topics covered include:

- Practical understanding of the ISPS Code & Australia's MTOFS Act & Regulations 2003
- Roles & responsibilities of governments and industry
- Security threats and vulnerabilities in port and at sea
- Access controls for ships, port and offshore facilities, security zones, identification systems
- General risk assessment principles – risk, threat and vulnerability – ISO 31000:2018
- Ship security assessments – initial preparation and revision
- Ship security plans – development, maintenance
- Compliance verification - audits and record-keeping
- Security threat mitigation and responses
- Additional security measures for ships in high risk areas – BMP5 – voyage planning
- Weapons and improvised explosive devices – methods of concealment and recognition
- Critical communication of sensitive information
- Encouraging security awareness and vigilance – ongoing training, drills and exercises
- Incident reporting obligations
- Harmonising the CSO and DPA roles
- Effective liaison with ship, port and / or offshore facility security officers
- Declaration of Security – correct usage and verification of undertakings

Who should attend

This course is for persons who will be required to perform the duties of a security officer as defined in the ISPS Code Part A/11.2 and MTOFS Reg 1.10. The course is also suitable for transport security inspectors (maritime) and law enforcement officers.

Entry standards

A basic understanding of ship, port or offshore safety management systems would be helpful. However, there are no specific pre-qualification requirements.

Locations & size

Courses are delivered at Pelagus's venues or in-house with class size limited to 8. Training at regional ports is our speciality.
