

3 Day Head / Offshore Facility Security Officer Training Course

ISPS Code & Australian MTOFS Act & Regulations 2003. To the requirements of the IMO Model Course 3.21.

This interactive classroom course is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, a former shipping industry executive with 50 years' of maritime industry involvement. His specialising in implementation of the ISPS Code and its associated codes, legislation and regulations commenced late in 2003, when the Code was conceived.

Aims

To provide essential knowledge to those who may be required to perform the duties of a Head / Offshore Facility Security Officer with responsibility for conducting a security assessment and developing and implementing the security plan for a fixed or floating offshore facility.

Topics covered include:

- Practical understanding of the ISPS Code & the Australian MTOFS Act & Regulations
- Roles & responsibilities of a government's designated authority and industry participants
- Ship & offshore security threats and vulnerabilities
- Access control for ships, offshore facilities and supply bases – restricted zones
- General risk assessment principles – ISO 31000:2018
- Offshore security assessments – development and review – ISO 20858:2007
- Offshore security plans – development, maintenance and review
- Administration – incident & event reports, audits and records
- Maritime and offshore security levels and routine measures
- Application of additional security measures in response to threats e.g. a rogue ship allision
- Weapons and prohibited items – methods of concealment – bomb searches
- Maintaining security awareness and vigilance – training, drills and exercises
- Incident reporting obligation
- Effective liaison with ships, ship operators and other maritime and offshore industry participants
- Harmonising the role with that of the DPA, under the ISM Code and/ or company OHS manager
- Declaration of Security – correct usage and verification of undertakings

Who should attend

This course is for persons who will be required to perform the duties of a security officer as defined in the ISPS Code Part A/17.2 and MTOFS Reg 1.33 or 1.34. The course is also suitable for transport security inspectors (maritime) and law enforcement officers.

Entry standards

A basic understanding of maritime transport and / or offshore facility operations would be helpful. However, there are no specific pre-qualification requirements.

Locations & size

Courses are delivered at Pelagus's venues or in-house with class size limited to 8. Training at regional ports is our speciality.
