

3 Day Port / Port Facility Security Officer Training Course

ISPS Code & Australian MTOFS Act & Regulations 2003. To the requirements of IMO Model Course 3.21 (2015).

This interactive classroom course is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, a former shipping industry executive with 50 years' of maritime industry involvement. His specialising in implementation of the ISPS Code and its associated codes, legislation and regulations commenced late in 2003, when the Code was conceived.

Aims

To provide essential knowledge to those who may be designated to perform the duties of a Port or Port Facility Security Officer with responsibility for security assessments, developing, maintaining and supervising the implementation of a maritime security plan and liaising with ship security officers and ship operators' company security officers.

Topics covered include:

- Practical understanding of the ISPS Code & the Australia's MTOFS Act & Regulations 2003
- Roles & responsibilities of government designated authorities and maritime industry key players
- Maritime Security Assessments – development and revision – ISO 20858:2007
- Applying general risk assessment principles – ISO 31000:2018
- Threat mitigation and responses – restricted zones – access controls and monitoring
- Maritime Security Plans – development, maintenance, audits and records
- Maritime security levels, routine and additional responses to security threats and directions
- Recognition on a non-discriminatory basis of persons posing security risks incl trusted insiders
- Managing and effectively communicating sensitive information
- Effective liaison with ships, ship operators and other maritime industry participants
- Declaration of Security – correct usage and verification of undertakings
- Weapons and other prohibited items – recognition including methods of concealment
- Bomb threats – search and evacuation considerations
- Encouraging security awareness and vigilance – training, inductions, drills and exercises
- Incident and event reporting – legal obligation

Who should attend

This course is for persons who will be required to perform the duties of a security officer as defined in the ISPS Code Part A/17.2 and MTOFS Reg. 1.20 or 1.25. The course is also suitable for transport security inspectors (maritime) and law enforcement officers.

Entry standards

A basic understanding of maritime transport operations would be helpful. However, there are no specific pre-qualification requirements.

Locations & size

Courses are delivered at Pelagus's venues or in-house with class size limited to 8. Training at regional ports is our speciality.
