

# 2 Day Training CoursePort & Facility Personnel with Designated Security Duties

ISPS Code & Australian MTOFS Act & Regulations 2003. To the requirements of the IMO Model Course 3.24.

This interactive classroom course is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, a former shipping industry executive with 50 years' of maritime industry involvement. His specialising in implementation of the ISPS Code and its associated codes, legislation and regulations commenced late in 2003, when the Code was conceived.

#### **Aims**

To provide essential knowledge to persons who may be designated to perform designated security-related duties such as liaison with security regulated ships, monitoring security zones, coordinating emergency responses, managing cargo handling operations and deliveries of ships stores.

## Topics covered include:

- Practical understanding of the ISPS Code & the Australian MTOFS Act & Regulations 2003
- Roles & responsibilities of government designated authorities and industry participants
- Maritime & offshore security threats, patterns and vulnerabilities incl cyber
- Recognition, on a non-discriminatory basis, of persons who are likely to threaten security
- Access control for ships, ports, port and offshore facilities, security zones, identification systems
- Techniques used to circumvent security measures
- Effective liaison between ship and shore communicating critical and sensitive information
- · Operation, testing, calibration and maintenance of security equipment and systems
- Bomb threats, security evacuations and crowd control
- Maintaining security awareness and vigilance land-side and water-side
- Incident reporting legal obligations and implications for failures
- Record keeping

### Who should attend

This course is for persons who have a key role in maintaining security at the ship / facility interface. For example: maritime security guard team leaders, technicians and shore officers at bulk liquids facilities, loading masters and ship loader operators at dry bulk facilities, harbour masters, VTS controllers, port pilots, ro-ro and container terminal yard planners, VBS managers and supervising stevedores.

# **Entry standards**

A basic understanding of maritime transport and/or offshore facility operations would be helpful. However, there are no specific pre-qualification requirements.

# Locations & size
